MASONIC DID YOU KNOW

Did you know that in 1916 a Resolution was adopted to change the election to present day usage as follows:

"The election and appointment of Officers of Florida shall take place at the first Stated Meeting in December of each year and such Officers shall be installed on the Anniversary of St. John the Evangelist or as soon thereafter as practicable. GL History Vol. IV pg. 192.

Prior to this change it was the previous Stated Communications to St. John the Evangelist. GL History Vol. IV pg. 119 this can be found in Art. VIII Sec. 6 of the 1846 Constitution GL History Vol. IV pg. 43.

Other Grand Lodges around the world and in the United States have their elections on other dates throughout the year, some are around St. John the Baptist Day of June 24th.

One of the reasons this is done to correspond more closely with the particular Grand Lodge year.
