<p>My Brothers,</p> <p>Greetings from the desk of your Chaplain. I’ve had questions about some of the terms used in Masonry, so I researched the Bible to answer some of those questions for me and thought you might be interested in the answers.</p> <p>What I found came from the King James version of the Holy Bible presented to me upon my raising. I also use my preaching NIV Bible for Verses used in our rituals. For instance, what is the term ‘cable tow” and how is it used in Masonry? This is what I have found; a “cable tow” is a rope used for leading. It’s significance to the three degrees of Masonry, is its symbolical employment binding candidates to their obligations.
