Solomon's reign and in the month of Ziv, he began the building of the Temple.

It was to be 90' In length 30' in width and 40' in height. The portico in front of the main hall extended out 15' and the width of the Hall, 30'.

There were clerestory windows set high into the walls. Solomon built a structure around the building which were side rooms, the lower of which was 7.5' wide the middle rooms were 9' wide and the top ones were 10.5' wide, this construction would prohibit anything from being inserted in to the Temple walls.

I plan to continue with the building of this magnificent structure next month.
