### CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

My Brothers,

I pray that this column finds all well, and those which we have been praying for on the mends.

Now back to the finishing up of the interior of this magnificent temple dedicated to God. The interior walls are lined with cedar paneling from floor to ceiling with floor covering of pine. The cedars were cut from the forests of Lebanon, floated to the port of Joppa then overland to the Temple.

The inside of the Temple was cedar lined, carved with gourds and open flowers so that none of the stones could be seen. The inner sanctuary within the Temple where the Arc of the Covenant was to be set was overlaid with pure gold which included the cedar Altar.

The inside of the Temple was also overlaid with pure gold, there had gold chains across the front of the inner sanctuary inside were a pair

of cherubim's of olive wood each sitting on the Altar with one of their wings meeting thus forming a seat for Solomon to sit. The cherubims were overlaid with gold. The cedar walls all around the Temple were carved with cherubim's, palm trees, and flowers.

The doors were covered with carved cherabims, palm trees, open flowers all of which were covered with hammered gold. I've cleaned these facts from 1 Kings chapter 6, it would be of great value if you would visit your Bible and read further both in this Chapter and in 2 Chronicles Chapter 2 thru 5 inclusively for more great information on that which is the base for your walk thru Masonry.
